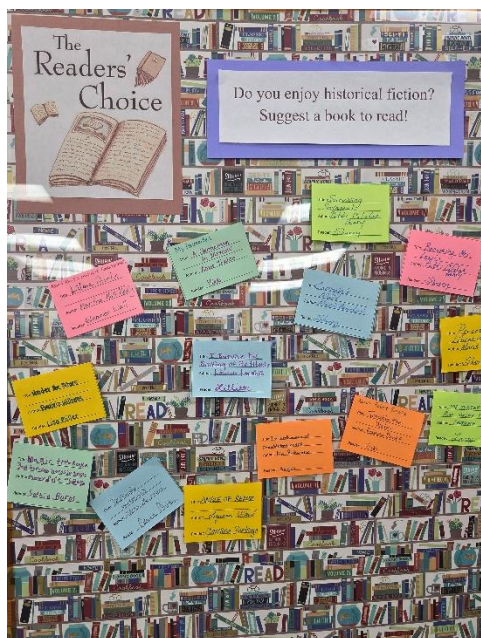

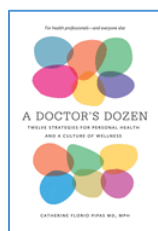

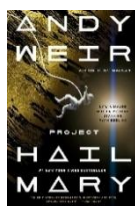
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Fahrenheit 451 by Ray Bradbury

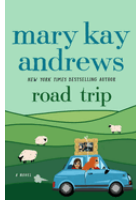
Murder by Design by Lee Goldberg
