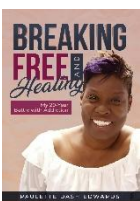
### STORY TIME AT PALMETTO PLAYHOUSE – Wednesdays from 9:30-10:00am

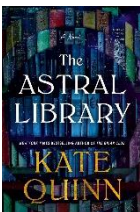
### BOOKS & BITES WITH ED R. GREEN – Thursday, June 25th, 4:00-6:00pm

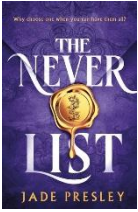
### **The Astral Library** by Kate Quinn

## The Never List by Jade Presley



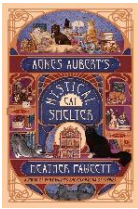

## Agnes Aubert's Mystical Cat Shelter by Heather Fawcett



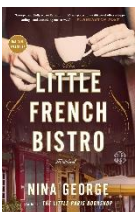
