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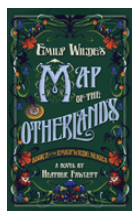
September Staff Picks – Reads we're recommending this month – all available in store!

Her observations, commentaries, emotions, and questions are chronicled through the years. Sybil, now in her seventies, uses the written word to reflect, make sense of relationships and connections, and to find meaning as she continues to move forward through the ups & downs of her life. 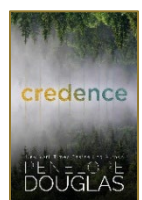
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Meet Me in Paris by Kristin Harmel
